Notes on this data summary:

- This Table on page 2 includes all cases that closed out of VR in FY 2006 with an employment outcome (Status 26) in a self-employment setting.
- The Table includes data from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and a total across all states and D.C.
- The Table includes information for three Groups of VR agencies: 1) Combined/General Agencies, 2) VR Agencies for the Blind, and 3) Combined/General Agencies and Agencies for the Blind together.
- In states where there is no VR Agency for the Blind, a “---“ appears in the cells under the Agency for the Blind section.
- Average weekly wage and hours worked are the calculate from the figures that were reported at the time of closure from VR services.
